### Skin Needling reactions

There is a small risk that skin can blister, sell, peel or scab. This is not expected to occur but may be a reaction due to the minimally invasive nature of micro-needling. Although all micro needling devices are one use only, sterile needles.

Reactions can include redness and flushing, stinging, tenderness and pinpoint bleeding – these effects usually subside within hours, however, some people react differently and find it can take a few days for skin to settle. Hormones can also make skin more sensitive.

There is a small risk of hyperpigmentation of the skin can occur, this is not usually expected but failure to follow the advice I give pre and post needling will increase your risk.
